On-duty time	Includes any time in CMV except sleeper -berth.	Does not include any time resting in a <u>parked</u> vehicle (also applies to passenger-carrying drivers). In a moving property-carrying CMV, does not include up to 2 hours in passenger seat immediately before or after 8 consecutive hours in sleeper-berth.
Penalties	"Egregious" hours of ser- vice violations not specifically defined.	Driving (or allowing a driver to drive) 3 or more hours beyond the driving-time limit may be considered an egregious violation and subject to the maximum civil penalties. Also applies to passenger-carrying drivers.



STEP 4: Right Side of Cab Area All items as done on left side of cab area

STEP 5: Fuel tank(s) Visible parts

STEP 6: Trailer Front Area Air and electrical lines and connections Lights and reflectors

STEP 7: Right Rear Tractor Wheels Area Dual wheels Suspension Tandem axles Brakes

STEP 8: Rear of Tractor Area Frame and cross members Lights and reflectors Air and electrical lines and connections

STEP 9: Coupling System Area Fifth-wheel (lower) Fifth-wheel (upper) Sliding fifth-wheel Air and electrical lines and connections

STEP 10: Right Side of Trailer Area Front trailer support (landing gear or dollies) Spare tire(s) Lights and reflectors Frame and body

STEP 11: Right Rear Trailer Wheels Area Dual tires Suspension Tandem axles Rrakes

STEP 12: Rear of Trailer Area Lights and reflectors Cargo securement

STEP 13: Left Rear Trailer Wheels Area
